SECOND HAND UNIFORMS Mainly small sizes, polar fleeces and jackets \$5 each, check availability with the office staff.

Parking and Road Safety

Already this term we have had a number of near misses due to unsafe road behaviour on Evanda Cres, near the dairy, roundabout and intersection over the bridge.

We have requested that the Auckland Transport wardens make extra visits to our area.

***Evanda Cres** has a **NO STOPPING ZONE** opposite the school office during pick up/drop times.

*PLEASE do not make dangerous turns at our school gates.

*PLEASE do not pull into driveways to drop off children.

*Having trouble finding a carpark? Try parking in one of the cul de sac streets and walk through the walkways into school, or parking further away and walking is a great option.

*PLEASE take care on our roads and have consideration for ALL of our students when dropping off and collecting children - this is a 40kmph zone and ensure you are modelling good road safety by using the allocated pedestrian crossings.
