**Evanda Crescent** - congestion on Evanda Cres could be reduced if we all drove one way = using **1** to enter and using **2** to exit

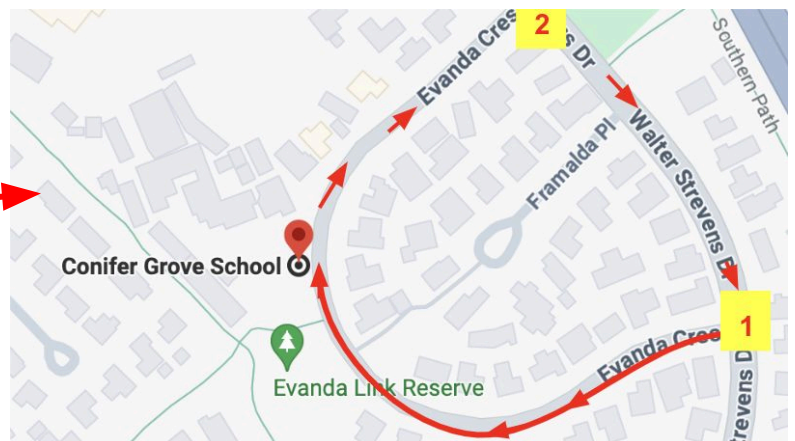
