Term 4 Learning



Literacy Reading

This term, for shared reading we have a focus on comprehension strategies, particularly questioning, to help students engage with texts by asking and answering meaningful questions. In guided reading, we are going to continue with novel study that encourages critical thinking and deeper understanding of texts.

Writing

In writing this term, we have a strong focus on building vocabulary skills, ensuring students are expanding their word knowledge and using new words confidently in their writing and conversations. Additionally students will enhance their organisation skills, learning how to structure their work effectively by creating well-formed paragraphs and understanding how chapters develop the flow of a story.

Nymeracy

Number

This term, our focus in mathematics will be on Number - Ratio & Proportion, where students will learn to compare quantities and solve related problems. We will also work on solving word problems, applying number skills to real-world situations. These activities aim to boost students' problem-solving abilities and build their confidence in math.

Strand

This term, students will focus on time, measurement, and temperature, learning to read time, understand units of measurement, and explore temperature changes. They will also study statistics by collecting data, creating graphs, and drawing conclusions through practical activities and real-world examples.

Conceptual

Context: Social Studies & Technology

This term, we are enhancing our class identity and teamwork through Social Studies and Technology lessons, focusing on mutual respect, clear communication, cooperation, and inclusion among tamariki.
