

Learning Focus

Conceptual Curriculum 2025:

This year, our school wide concept is focusing on **change** and we will be exploring the big understanding of 'Change occurs in different ways that may initiate reactions, opportunities, and / or challenges.'

During this learning, we will be focusing on:

How the past is important to people and how people's lives have changed How change over time can impact positively or negatively on the present (e.g., clothing, toys, technology, transport, housing, food)

How positive relationships with people can make their lives happier How people can take action to improve environments that can be enjoyed by others

Literacy:

At Conifer Grove School we follow a structured literacy approach, where we systematically learn how to decode and encode sounds and words that enable reading and writing. There will be opportunities to share more about how this approach works throughout the year.

Mathematics:

In Tipu we will be developing early number knowledge and strategies to solve problems, and exploring other mathematical strands such as measurement and geometry.

Values:

Our focus for Term 1 is **Whakamiha** or **Respect**. You can help develop this by talking to your child about what respect looks like in different situations. For example, respecting personal space, taking turns, or treating others with kindness, regardless of differences.

The best way to support your child's learning is to talk to them about their day.
